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INTRODUCTION

The Manual for the Contest and Jury Evaluation Software has been developed and modified by the International Center for New Media, Moosstrasse 43a, 5020 Salzburg, Austria, and is intended to be used as a standard contest guideline by an organizer of any national or international contest on e-content, based on the procedure developed by the ICNM.

In case of agreement on the both sides, a MOU (Memorandum of Understanding) and a contract will be signed between the ICNM and the „NATIONAL CONTEST“. Any kind of use and implementation of the Software and the Manual out of the „NATIONAL CONTEST“ is absolutely excluded and will be considered as a copyright infringement. The circulation of the Software, the Know-How and the Manual for any other purposes than „NATIONAL CONTEST“ is also strongly prohibited and will be considered as a copyright infringement (Contract, § 4 Right concerning the Know-How).

The Contest and Jury Evaluation Software and Manual have been developed entirely in the English language and are offered to the Partner as such. The user interface and all correspondence intended to be sent to participants of the contest as automatic Emails can be, upon request, translated into the native language, either by the ICNM or in exceptional cases, by the Partner on consultation with the ICNM.

In order to adapt the interface of the Software to the layout of a particular contest website, the „NATIONAL CONTEST“ receives a link to a template registration form. It is the Partner's responsibility to adapt the layout of that page and send it to the WSA Office at least two 2 weeks prior to the software launch.

Changes, modifications or adaptations are possible upon the Partner's request and will be billed additionally (Contract, § 5 Costs and Transactions).

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
